SWPPI Requirements

All Phase II permittee holders, including County Agencies and Nested Jurisdictions (schools) are required to train appropriate staff on stormwater issues and management procedures.

Appropriate staff includes anyone employed by or working for a Municipality or Governmental Agency that is responsible for operation and maintenance of publicly owned property. (i.e. parking lot sweeping, salt application, fertilizer/pesticide application, fleet maintenance) Permittees and nested jurisdictions should send an outdoor supervisor(s), employee(s) and contractor(s.)

The NPDES Phase II permit requires a training and inspection program for staff and contractors employed by the permittee in activities that may affect storm water. It is a permit requirement of this program that staff shall go through training each permit cycle (every 5-years.) New employees within one year of employment.

Non Phase II permittees are not required, but welcome to attend

Good Housekeeping Training

Good Housekeeping Training covers proper maintenance and practices that address (surface) water quality. The topics covered are required in the Phase II permit such as:

- Proper handling of chemicals
- Proper maintenance of equipment that address surface water quality
- Vehicle washing / maintenance
- Street/parking lot maintenance
- Material / waste storage
- Landscaping
- Maintenance and inspection of storm sewer system (MS4)
- Record keeping
